We are excited to announce that we have now formalised our agreement to merge into Relationships Australia South Australia (RASA). This transition will occur on 1 December. We will be taking our highly respected name and programs into this partnership, as well as transferring all current staff involved in their delivery.

RASA has an exemplary reputation for quality. It has been providing family services in South Australia for nearly 70 years and its staff of 300 currently assists over 26,000 people each year throughout the state. RASA's programs open up new and expanded opportunities to support our children and families through internal referral, contributing to even greater long-term outcomes for children in need.
